1 Climate and disaster risk information systems

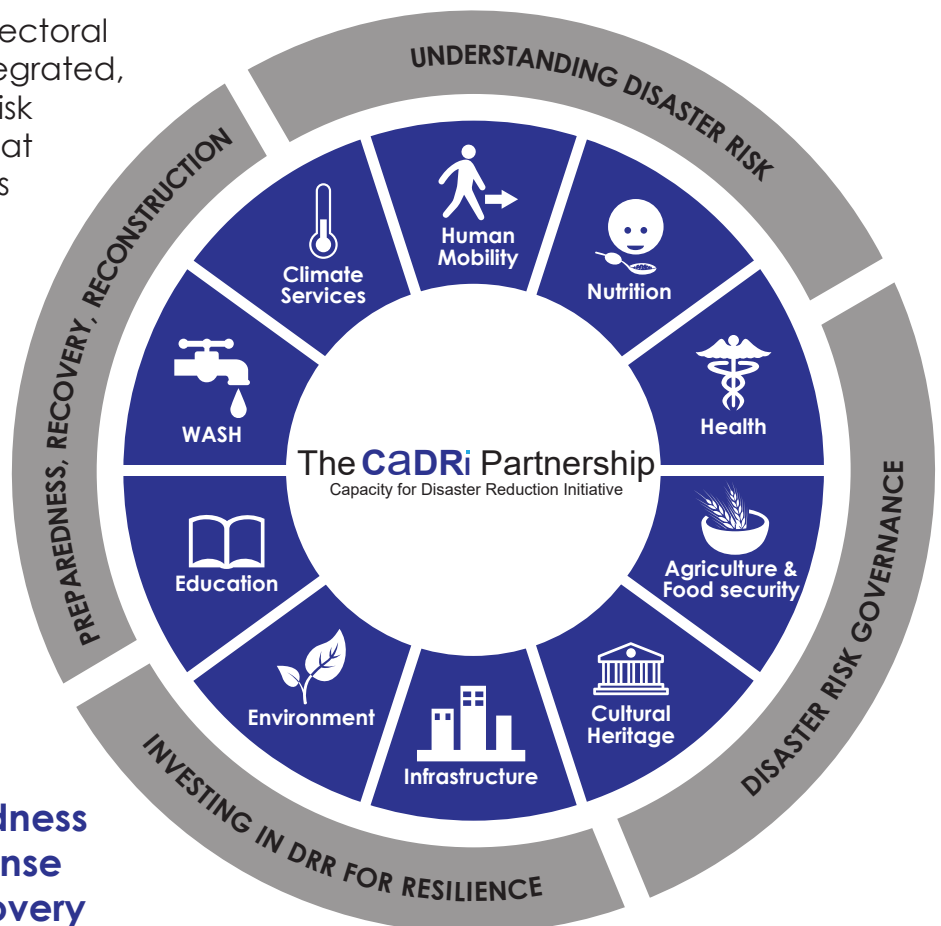
Deployment of multi-sectoral expertise to set up integrated, multi-hazard country risk information systems that are accessible to users at all levels.
